#### **ABRAHAM'S BOSOM**

**NT:2859 kolpos** (kol'-pos); apparently a primary word; the bosom; by analogy, a bay: KJV-bosom, creek.

**OT:2436 cheyq** (khake); or cheq (khake); and chowq (khoke); from an unused root, apparently meaning to inclose; the bosom (literally or figuratively): -bosom, bottom, lap, midst, within.

#### **ETERNITY**

**OT:5769** `owlam (o-lawm'); or `olam (o-lawm'); from **OT:5956**; properly, concealed, i.e. the vanishing point; generally, time out of mind (past or future), i.e. (practically) eternity; frequentatively, adverbial (especially with prepositional prefix) always: KJV-alway (-s), ancient (time), any more, continuance, eternal, (for, [n-]) ever (-lasting, -more, of old), lasting, long (time), (of) old (time), perpetual, at any time, (beginning of the) world (+without end). Compare OT:5331, **OT:5703**.

**OT:5956** `alam (aw-lam'); a primitive root; to veil from sight, i.e. conceal (literally or figuratively): KJV-X any ways, blind, dissembler, hide (self), secret (thing). **OT:5703** `ad (ad); from **OT:5710**; properly, a (peremptory) terminus, i.e. (by implication) duration, in the sense of advance or perpetuity (substantially as a noun, either with or without a preposition): KJV-eternity, ever (-lasting, -more), old, perpetually, + world without end.

**OT:5710 `adah** (aw-daw'); a primitive root; to advance, i.e. pass on or continue; causatively, to remove; specifically, to bedeck (i.e. bring an ornament upon): KJV-adorn, deck (self), pass by, take away.

**NT:165 aion** (ahee-ohn'); from the same as **NT:104**; properly, an age; by extension, perpetuity (also past); by implication, the world; specially (Jewish) a Messianic period (present or future): KJV-age, course, eternal, (for) ever (-more), [n-] ever, (beginning of the while the) world (began, without end). Compare NT:5550.

**NT:104 aei** (ah-eye'); from an obsolete primary noun (apparently meaning continued duration); "ever," by qualification regularly; by implication, earnestly; KJV-always, ever.

#### **HEAVEN**

**OT:8064 shamayim** (shaw-mah'-yim); dual of an unused singular shameh (shaw-meh'); from an unused root meaning to be lofty; the sky (as aloft; the dual perhaps alluding to the visible arch in which the clouds move, as well as to the higher ether where the celestial bodies revolve): KJV-air, X astrologer, heaven (-s).

#### **PARADISE**

**NT:3857 paradeisos** (par-ad'-i-sos); of Oriental origin [compare **OT:6508**]; a park, i.e. (specifically) an Eden (place of future happiness, "paradise"): KJV-paradise.

**OT:6508 pardec** (par-dace'); of foreign origin; a park: KJV-forest, orchard.



# Earth's Heaven: As a Type of God's Heaven

And God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." And God made the expanse and separated the waters that were under the expanse from the waters that were above the expanse. And it was so. And **God called the expanse Heaven**. Then the Lord said to Moses, "Behold, I am about to rain bread from heaven for you, and the people shall go out and gather a day's portion every day, that I may test them, whether they will walk in my law or not. Exodus 16:4 ESV
